

2025 Summer Head Start Program

The DAC Summer Head Start Program is a partnership between the Decatur Athletic Club (DAC) and the United States Tennis Association (USTA).

\$599 (30 hours) for 9- to 13-year-olds • \$799 (40 hours) for high school players

Payment may be divided into two parts due May 23rd and July 4th, respectively.

This program provides a lot of quality court time to give some a head start on their competition and for others an opportunity to learn how to play tennis.

Players of all levels are welcome. Classes are divided by ages with plenty of instructors available, so each participant receives focused instruction based on ability.

Classes meet twice a week for ten consecutive weeks at DAC.

Who should participate?

High school students who have never played before but are considering joining their high school team during the 2025 - 2026 school year.

Students who have never played before and want to learn the basics of the sport.

Players who want to take advantage of their summer vacation and get 30 or 40 hours of quality instruction and play in during the off-season, so they are better prepared for upcoming competitions.
